

The New Brunswick Equestrian Association's Policy - Provincially Recognized Officials

- A Provincially Recognized Official is accredited only within the Province of New Brunswick.
- Provincial Officials are responsible for obtaining their own insurance
- NBEA approves provincial officials for Dressage Provincial Competitions and Bronze General Performance

To maintain status:

- A Provincial Official must be an Adult member in good standing with the New Brunswick Equestrian Association.
- A GP Provincially Recognized Official must attend one National or Provincially hosted officials' development seminar/course within each three year period.
- A Dressage Provincially Recognized Official must possess a valid Equine Canada Gold Sport license and include Dressage New Brunswick as one of their references on the application. Those applying must have shadowed with an EC Dressage Judge or have attended a Dressage Judging seminar approved by Equine Canada.
- In order to maintain status all Provincially Recognized Judges must assume the responsibility of notifying the NBEA of current contact information.

Review:

A Provincial Recognized Official's conduct and ability must be exemplary and is subject to continual review. The accreditation is revocable at any time by the NBEA. Appeals of such decision must be made in writing and addressed to the New Brunswick Equestrian Association.

Application Process:

- Complete and return the Provincial Official's application form to the New Brunswick Equestrian Association prior to January 30th of the current year. Written notification of applicants will be completed by February 30th of the current year.
- Applicants must be Adult members in good standing with the New Brunswick Equestrian Association.
