Equine Canada - Statement of Principles

Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

All Persons shall be committed to:

Upholding the welfare of the horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;

•Ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers and competitors, or their respective agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;

•Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;

•providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives;

•Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;

•Requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competition;

•actively promoting the development and adherence of competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horses.

The Standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person, who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

Morgan Breed Show Rules

- 1. Equine Canada Bronze sport license is required for all exhibitors and owners.
- Amateur number and cards must be present for all Amateur to Ride/Drive/ Handle classes.
- Horses must be entered under the names of the owner(s) or lessee of record with CMHA, AMHA, or BMHS. A copy of the registration papers showing recorded ownership or proof of lease must be submitted with the entry form at the time of making entry.
- 3. Horses entering Maritime Bred Classes must be able to document breeding. (Sire and Dam)
- 4. The Morgan shall be shown in all its NATURAL beauty with full mane, forelock, and tail. Braiding is permitted only in Hunter, Jumper, Dressage, and Carriage classes or in classes when shown under proper hunter/dressage tack and attire.
- 5. Riders in classes for Junior Competitors must not have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the following competition year. The age requirements set out in this rule defining adults and juniors shall supersede the definition for "junior(s)" and "adult(s)" set out in all Equine Canada rules, regulations, agreements and policies applicable to the Morgan Division. B5202.5

Junior classes may be divided as follows:

- 13 years and under
- 14 to 17 years
- 6. An open class is one which is open to all horses of any age irrespective of the ribbons previously won and in which there are no qualifications for the rider/driver.
- 7. Shoeing -Regulations regarding length of toe and weight of shoe including pad shall be strictly enforced Competitions offering classes in a Division that designates a maximum weight for shoes must provide accurate scales for weighing. If any horse casts a shoe in any of these classes, the shoe including pad if used, but not including nails must be immediately weighed by the Judge. In these classes, a competitor may not be excused from the ring until the Judge is satisfied that the horse has not cast a shoe (B5205). Except for weanlings and yearlings which must be shown barefoot, horses may be shod or barefoot. If shod shoes, rocker bars or Memphis bars, the bars must not extend below the bottom of the plane of the shoe. Weight attached to the exterior of the hoof is prohibited. Barium or standard screw-in caulks are allowed. There are three different length and/or weight restrictions according to the section or class within the Morgan Division. In Classic Pleasure classes, full pads are prohibited, horses may be shown with or without rim pads. The weight of the shoe, including rim pads, must not exceed 16 ounces, and the length of toe including shoe and pads must not exceed 4-1/2 inches. In Pleasure (except Classic Section), Pleasure Driving and Natural Park classes, there are no specific shoe weight limits but the length of toe must not exceed 5 inches including pad and shoe. In all In-Hand classes, Parade, Park Saddle, Park Harness, Hunter, Jumper, Eventing, Cutting, Reining, Carriage, Equitation and all other Morgan classes, there are no specific shoe weight limits but the length of toe must not exceed 5-3/4 inches including pads and shoe. At an All Morgan Competition, all Champions and Reserve Champions must have one foot measured immediately upon leaving the ring except in classes where points are accumulated to determine

Championships.

- Coloured brow bands may be worn in all classes except when hunt seat or dressage attire and tack is required.
- 9. Appointments (B5207)shall be such as are appropriate for horses shown in the particular class. Boots and artificial appliances are forbidden except in Reining, Roadster, Jumper, Hunt Seat Equitation, and Stock Seat (Pattern/Reining) Equitation where **boots** are permissible (B5207.3). Braiding is permitted only in hunter, dressage and carriage classes (B5207.1). Park classes under saddle shall be shown in English tack (saddle seat). An inconspicuous tongue tie is permitted in all Morgan sections with the exception of Carriage Driving, Dressage, and Hunter over Fences, Reining Seat Equitation, Western Seat Equitation, Trail, Reining, and Western Pleasure.
- 10. Rider attire should be suitable to the saddle being ridden (B5208). Any competitor may wear approved protective headgear in any division. Riders in Western tack (B 5803.1) must wear suitable hat, a long sleeved shirt with a collar; a necktie, kerchief, bolo tie or pin; trousers or pants(one piece equitation suit acceptable provided it has a collar) and boots. Riders must wear chaps, shotgun chaps. A vest, jacket, coat, and/or sweater may also be worn. Spurs are optional. Recommended for English Pleasure (B5602.2) and Classic English Pleasure (B5702.2) Park Saddle (B5502.2) (flat English Saddle): Informal attire recommended is a saddle suit or day coat with contrasting jodhpurs, vest, boots and appropriate derby, soft hat or approved protective headgear. Formal attire is worn only after 6:00 PM and consists of a tuxedo style saddle suit, formal shirt with appropriate tie, vest or cummerbund, and boots. Gloves, whips, spurs optional. Hunter Pleasure (B5903) (Forward Seat saddle) Informal Attire. Recommended informal attire should include traditional hunter-style jacket, breeches or hunter jodhpurs, dark hunting cap, derby or approved protective headgear, and appropriate boots. A stock choker or four-in-hand tie with any color shirt is correct. 3. Formal Attire. Recommended formal attire consists of a hunter shadbelly with buff or canary breeches, stock tie, canary vest, top hat and hunt boots. Formal attire (shadbelly) is optional for all female competitors after 6:00 PM or in Championship classes held at any time. 4. In all classes, gloves, hunter crop or bat, spurs and appointments are optional. It is not mandatory that a Junior Competitors wear approved protective headgear harness.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR or SAFETY VESTS - Any competitor may wear protective headgear in any Division, Section or class without penalty from the judge. (B5208.2)

<u>Show Rule</u> Junior Exhibitors are to wear protective headgear during schooling and warm up. Junior Exhibitors participating in classes which allow western hats or derbies may wear traditional headgear during their class changing from protective headgear dismounted when the class preceding enters the competition arena.

11. Championship Awards (High Point Basis) will be calculated on each horse rider/driver combination in the following divisions.

Champion Morgan Carriage - Classes 41, 55, 58, 99, 118

Champion Morgan Junior Exhibitor - Classes 31, 50, 47, 60, 73, 85, 102 and 106.

McMonagle Prize – This is a perpetual award saluting the versatility of the New Brunswick Morgan Horse. It's offered in tribute to Sussex Vale businessman and sportsman Hugh McMonagle who introduced the breed to New Brunswick in the mid-1800s. Eligible horses must have either been foaled in New Brunswick or have lived here for one full calendar year prior to the show. The winner receives a perpetual plaque that is theirs to keep for the year, accompanied by a selection of New Brunswick gift items. Goals: To promote the quality and profile of New Brunswick Morgan Horses, to celebrate the versatility of the breed encouraging the breeding of quality Morgan's in New Brunswick. Classes 7, 16, 28, 39, 56, 58, 59, 62, 78, 80, 112 In the case of a tie, the two top finishers will be presented to the judge in hand one last time for the declaration of the ultimate winner.

General Show Rules

- 1. NO ABUSE TO HORSES WILL BE TOLERATED
- 2. "Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location." (A602.5)

- 3. Competitors' numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise rings, as well as the competition ring. (A814). There will be a charge of \$5.00 each for back numbers. This will be refunded when the numbers are returned to the show secretary at the end of the show.
- 4. All horses must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor or under legal lease (copy of which must be provided). Horses purchased on time are permitted to be shown and entered in any class under the Purchaser's name providing a written contract of sale can be produced to the Show Secretary.
- 5. All cheques are to be made payable to the NB MORGAN HORSE CLUB. No postdated cheques will be accepted after the official closing date for entries.
- 6. Owner's full name, complete address, and postal code must be on entry form.
- 7. There is no fee for Championship In-Hand classes.
- 8. Ribbons will be awarded to five places. Trophies or prizes may be presented in some classes.
- 9. An open class is one which is open to all horses of any age irrespective of the ribbons previously won and in which there are no qualifications for the rider/driver.
- 10. It is strongly recommended that all horses be inoculated against rabies, influenza, rhino-pneumonitis and strangles. Any persistent coughing or obviously ill horse will be barred from the show grounds for their own and others protection. It is strongly recommended that the horses have a current negative coggins test.
- 11. A judge must order from the ring any unruly or unsafe horse or rider.
- 12. There will be no refund of class fees unless the horse is withdrawn due to serious illness or injury to the horse (veterinary certification required) or serious illness, injury or death in the exhibitor's family. In these cases 75% of entry fees 100% of Equine medications, stabling fees and number fees will be refunded. No refund on administration fee. If horse is already on competition grounds only 75% of entry fees will be refunded. A suitable horse may be substituted.

13. IMPORTANT!

<u>Scratches</u> Exhibitors must notify the show secretary and/or in-gate attendant in a timely matter well before the class if they withdraw their horse from a class or change rider/driver. It is important to have proper information for the show result forms! Classes begin no later than <u>5 minutes</u> after the last horse leaves the ring from the previous class.

<u>Tack holds</u> Exhibitors must notify the show secretary and/or in-gate attendant a minimum of (3) three exhibitor attended classes prior to the requested hold. Conduct of hold: The gate will be closed after previous class exits ring and will stay closed until the competitor who requested the hold is ready or the allotted hold time has expired. The gate will then be opened and all competitors will enter the ring. Tack hold will be an additional <u>3 minutes</u> added to time allowed between classes.

- 14. The indoor show ring will be open for use 12:00 noon the day prior to the commencement of the show and will close at 10:00 PM that night. Possible other times TBA.
- 15. Warm up ring & in gate: Priority is for horses in the next class. Please be courteous and do schooling and early warm up in the cattle penning ring. No lunging in arena at any time when a mounted rider is present. No Lunging during competition hours. There will be no conduct in the warm up area or in-gate area, which disturbs or creates a hazard to the horses or handlers. Bag whips, noise makers, rattlers, chains, buckets and cans with rocks, or other equipment, devices or objects which might disturb a horse or exhibitor or create a hazard to horses or handlers in the paddock or in-gate area are **PROHIBITED**.
- 16. Horses shall be shown at all gaits both ways of the ring. In harness classes, all drivers shall remain seated until all entries have been inspected and judged. One attendant without whip must head each horse in Park and Pleasure Driving classes. In Pleasure classes horses may be asked to back. Stallions MUST be under control at all times and shown by a COMPETENT HANDLER. JUNIOR EXHIBITORS ARE PROHIBITED

FROM SHOWING STALLIONS.

- 17. The show reserves the right to cancel a class if there are less than three entries.
- 18. Hors Concours entries will not be permitted in the competition.
- 19. Parking available on the grounds. Please park horse trailers between barn 3 and the hockey arena or next to the barns. For safety reasons we would like to keep the warm-up area uncluttered. Travel trailers parked by the warm-up area may not be moved during competition hours.
- 20. Entries may leave the show grounds following their last class.
- 21. As per Equine Canada rule A805, the show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, except as provided in A805.2.
- 22. **PROFESSIONAL SERVICES:** Payment for professional service or consultations performed by the Show Veterinarian, Farrier or Photographer will be the responsibility of the exhibitor only. **NBMHC will not be held responsible for these services**.
- 23. For insurance purposes, all horses must have a stall. No tying to trailers.
- 24. Entry forms must be signed by exhibitor, owner and person responsible. If the owner or exhibitor is a junior, the entry must be signed by a parent or legal guardian. The entry form for all sanctioned competitions shall also be signed by the person responsible for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse. By definition, The Person Responsible is the individual responsible and accountable for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse. The Person Responsible may be the trainer, owner, rider, driver, agent or coach. The Person Responsible must be an adult who holds a valid EC Sport License.

If the owner of the horse is a Junior the parent/guardian may sign as person responsible who must be at minimum a registered participant. Registered Participant Any person registered with Equine Canada, including Sport License Holders, and paying dues to obtain some benefit from Equine Canada. The cost of a registered participant/non-competitive license is \$15. However, please note that all provincial equestrian federation members (NBEA/NSEF) automatically receive EC registered participant status.

The person responsible is to be present at the competition and if they cannot attend must appoint a representative and notify the competition secretary.

Every class herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of Equine Canada Rule Book and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC rule book. (A6O2.2) This show will run in accordance with the Code of Ethics of Equine Canada. Any situation requiring a ruling which cannot be referenced according to the Equine Canada rules will be rendered by the Show Committee.

"Per Article A801, Every entry at an EC sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in this EC sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition."(A602.7)
