Clinic Information:

The clinic is designed for those individuals who:

- want to pursue or update their EC combined driving officials' license
- are thinking about becoming an EC combined driving official
- simply want to learn more about the rules and requirements of combined driving events

The clinic will review the Equestrian Canada rules for driving - Section C and will follow the guidelines for officials education developed by the EC Driving Committee in 2017.

The clinic will cover the role and duties of a combined driving judge, technical delegate and course designer. It will provide examples and insights into officiating at combined driving events. The clinic is an 8 hour classroom review of the sport of combined driving, the rules and the officials roles.

There will be an opportunity to see examples during the weekend as there is a driving skills clinic being conducted at the same facility on May 19, 20, 21 2018.
