

## **Coach/Instructor Training Opportunities**

NSEF is pleased to provide our certified coaches and instructors with an opportunity to become trained in our new entry level program, Rookie Riders. As an ongoing effort to partner with Equestrian Canada and provincial/Territorial Equestrian associations, we will be launching this program nationally in the coming months. Before we can launch, we need to have you ready to offer the program in your facility.

The Rookie Riders program is a safe and fun introduction to riding skills, horses and horsemanship. Using a barrel and other specially made equipment, this is a riding and gymnastics focused program that will develop skills for equestrian sport. Trained coaches and instructors will use this program as a fundamental and progressive approach to riding. The exciting part of this new program is that you can offer Rookie Riders at a stable or gymnasium and it can be held anytime of the year.

During this training session, our facilitators will guide you through each component to ensure you are comfortable in delivering it on your own. You will be provided with the resources and manuals. The Rookie Riders barrel can be purchased by you and some will be available to rent. Please come dressed to participate in leading activities (with indoor sneakers for gym) with children.
