The NBEA would like to thank you for your support in our effort to increase Biosecurity at horse shows. Requiring mandatory vaccinations as a condition for entry at your competition is an important contribution to horse welfare.



To show our appreciation for your leadership, the NBEA will award \$200 to sanctioned competition that makes the following criteria a mandatory requirement for entry at their horse show(s).

- Vaccinations against Influenza, Rhinopneumonitis and Strangles
- Coggins certificate (yearly)

To receive the annual \$200 Biosecurity Incentive, please register your competition by June 18th and send your submission form within 10 days of your competition or last competition organized by you in 2018.

Prize Lists for all registered competitions must be emailed to the NBEA and will be linked with your competition date on the NBEA website calendar. Please review the attached forms so that you will not miss the application or submission dates.
