This year, the NBEA will assist junior members achieve their equestrian goals, awarding up to six bursaries of \$500 each.

What can the money be used for?

The bursaries can be used to help pay for the following:

- Riding lessons/Rider Level testing
- Training fees
- Competition fees
- Continuing education
- Other activities that will assist you to achieve your equestrian objectives

Who can apply? (Riders participating in the LTED 2019 program are not eligible.)

If you can answer **yes** to the following questions you are eligible to apply!

- Are you a current NBEA Junior Member between the ages of 14 and 18?
- Are you currently attending school in New Brunswick?
- Have you completed or are ready to be tested for at least one Rider Level?
- Do you train with an Equestrian Canada current certified coach?

How to apply?

Only applications that include the following items will be considered complete and eligible:

- Completed Youth Bursary Application Form
- Essay #1 Describe your horse interests and experiences (200 words or less)
- Essay #2 Indicate how you would spend \$500 (200 words or less)
- Photo colour photo of you riding/driving OR your head shot
- Two Letters of Recommendation from your coach, who has a license and NBEA/EC membership that is up to date and one from an independent supporter who is an NBEA member.
