Please provide a letter(s) from a sponsor, owner/rider of horses trained to supporting your training experience.)	
Coaching Experience	
At least two years coaching experience producing students competing at Second Level or higher, with a minimum score of 60% at Gold shows (Any documentation providing evidence such as: Name/date of shows, names of judges, copy of judge's sheet. Please provide a letter(s) from a sponsor/parent/rider supporting your coaching experience.)

Competitive Experience  To have successfully completed courses at a minimum of two (2) shows at 3'6" (1m10) in the hunter or jumper divisions at Silver or Gold shows (Any documentation providing evidence such as: Name/date of shows, name of judges a letter(s) from a sponsor/coach/show official supporting your competitive experience.)
