





2020 LTED EVENTING PROGRAM

PROGRAM OUTLINE

The LTED program is an NBEA funded program developed and administered by HTNB.

HTNB MISSION STATEMENT:

- o Our mission is to:
 - · Remove barriers to participation
 - Facilitate a pathway to progress and success
 - Foster entry to the sport and support lifelong participation
 - · Increase safety and enjoyment by increasing competence
 - Promote volunteering
 - Promote education and horse welfare

PROGRAM OPTIONS:

- Development Tier: For those new to the sport or wish to advance at lower levels.
 - Starter (12"- 22")
 - Pre-Entry (2'3")
- Competitive Tier: For those who wish to further their skills and knowledge in eventing.
 - Tier 1: Entry (2'9")
 - Tier 2: Pre-Training (3')
 - Tier 3: Training (3'3") and EV105 (1.05m / 3'5")
 - <u>NOTE:</u> Competitive Tier riders may also be considered for year-end championship and/or elite competition. Only LTED riders who meet program requirements are considered (see guidelines below).

- *NOTE: Derby entry fee funded for Competitive Tier 3 riders. Horse trial entry fee funded for Competitive Tier 1 & Tier 2 riders.







HOW TO APPLY:

- Riders to submit an LTED application to NBEA by **March 6, 2020**. Please include:
 - Application form with letter of support from your coach
 - Payment information, cheques made payable to NBEA
 - Proof of memberships: <u>all LTED</u> applicants must have NBEA & HTNB
 - <u>Competitive Tier</u> riders and all planning to compete need proof of EC membership appropriate to level (Bronze+)
 - Proof of vaccinations (flu/rhino/tetanus, strangles) and a negative coggins test (dated 2020) must be provided two weeks prior to first LTED activity.
 - <u>Competitive Tier</u> riders must submit proof of vaccinations no later than <u>April 3rd, 2020</u> to attend their mandatory <u>Competitive Training Clinic.</u>
 - <u>Development Tier</u> riders must submit proof of vaccinations no later than <u>June 19th, 2020</u> to attend their mandatory <u>Development Training</u> <u>Clinic.</u>
 - If attending Camp #1, submit proof of vaccinations no later than **April 17th, 2020.**

CRITERIA FOR ALL LTED RIDERS:

- Riders must complete the designated Equestrian Canada Rider Level or Canadian Pony Club Level by **October 12**, **2020** to be eligible for funding (see tier breakdown).
- All LTED riders to develop training plans for the 2020 LTED program and submit a progress report with their LTED Completion Form by October 12, 2020.
- 25% refund provided for horse or rider injury with vet/physician explanation prior to July 31^{st]}
- Horse substitutions allowed after approval from the LTED coordinator. Approval must occur prior to continuing LTED activities: camps, clinics, or competitions.
- Please note that participants who may need financial accommodations should contact HTNB.
- To receive funding, each rider is responsible for submitting a LTED Completion Form no later than **October 12, 2020.**
- Funding is limited. In the case of more than 24 competitive riders, selection will be at the discretion of the HTNB board.

GUIDELINES FOR COACHING/COMPETITION/CHAMPIONSHIPS:

- Coaching for jumping at HTNB competitions is funded and provided by HTNB. Coaching may
 be arranged for out-of-province competitions with 1-month notice. Course walks will be
 scheduled by level.
- Entry fees to select HTNB competitions included for **Competitive Tier only** see calendar.
- ALL HTNB competitors are welcome to declare for Team NB competing at Maritime Eventing Challenge. Watch for updates on qualifications and key dates.
- Each year, the NBEA funds a LTED team to travel to a year-end competition (TBD). This is open only to Competitive Tier LTED riders at Pre-Training level and above who have declared and met all qualification criteria. Watch for updates on qualifications and key dates.







DEVELOPMENT TIER

Starter (12-22") and Pre-Entry (2'3") Divisions

OBJECTIVE:

The Development Tier has been redesigned this year to focus on introducing new riders to eventing and allow them experience cross country in a fun, educational, supportive environment tailored to their level. The objective of the development tier is to expose more riders to eventing and in particular, cross-country experiences. To that end, the program will not fund competitions at this level but rather focus on supporting education and training opportunities in accordance with LTED guidelines.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Riders must attend Development Training Clinic ("Introduction to Eventing and Cross Country") as well as either Camp #2 or Camp #3. Please note development riders are welcome and fully funded at all camps.
- Riders are encouraged to compete in at least one sanctioned HTNB competition. Entry fees
 are <u>not</u> funded at this level, though coaching for jumping at HTNB competitions will be
 available at no cost.
- Education is a priority for all LTED riders. HTNB is committed to assisting Development Tier riders achieve their rider levels through clinics, study materials, and mentoring.
- Minimum Rider Level requirements, deadline October 12, 2020:
 - Riders without EC Rider Level 3 at time of application must complete EC Rider Level 3.
 - Riders with EC Rider Level 3 at time of application must complete EC Rider Level 4 or Canadian Pony Club D1.
- Fee: \$150
- Riders submit a LTED Completion Form by October 12, 2020.







COMPETITIVE TIERS

Entry Division (2'9"), Pre-Training Division (3'), Training (3'3") and EV105 (1.05m) Divisions

OBJECTIVE:

The overall objective of the competitive tiers is to obtain training through structured lessons and camps and demonstrate development and growth via competitive experiences and results, as well as advancement in rider levels.

REQUIREMENTS (see specifics below):

- Competitive Tier riders MUST attend Competitive Training Clinic and choice of one other camp but are welcome and funded at all camps as members of the program. Camps do not count toward lessons requirements.
- Riders must compete in HTNB competitions and EC sanctioned horse trials.
- Competitive Tier Riders will train with EC certified Instructors and/or Competition
 Coaches appropriate to level, with cost subsidies reimbursed at the end of the program reimbursement forms due October 12, 2020.

Coaches must provide proof of insurance to NBEA. Riders may not coach themselves.

COMPETITIVE TIER 1 CRITERIA- Entry Division (2'9")

- As stated above, riders must attend Competitive Training Clinic and at least one other camp
 of their choice.
- Riders must compete in at least 1 HTNB competition AND 1 EC sanctioned horse trial (may be out-of- province).
- Riders to complete a minimum of 2 lessons per month (May August) with EC Certified Instructor or Competition Coach for a total of 8 lessons.
- At least 1 lesson/month must be a cross-country lesson for a total of **4 XC lessons**. Must be HTNB approved course with a HTNB XC **Instructor or Competition Coach**.
- Must complete EC Rider Level 5 / Canadian Pony Club D2 or higher by October 12, 2020.
- Fee: \$175
- Lesson subsidy of \$200 is provided at end of program through submission of LTED Completion Form by **October 12, 2020**, which is solely the responsibility of the rider.
- Entry fee to HTNB horse trial at Peakaboo Corner is included.







COMPETITIVE TIER 2 CRITERIA - Pre-Training Division (3')

- As stated above, riders must attend Competitive Training Clinic and at least one other camp
 of their choice.
- Riders must compete in at least 1 HTNB competition AND 2 EC sanctioned horse trials (may be out-of-province).
- Riders to complete a minimum of 4 lessons per month (May August) with EC Certified Competition Coach for a total of 16 lessons. <u>Lessons with EC Certified Instructors are not included at this level and do not count toward lesson requirements.</u>
- At least 1 lesson/month must be a cross-country lesson for a total of **4 XC lessons**. Must be HTNB approved course with a HTNB XC **Competition Coach**.
- Must complete EC Rider Level 6 / Canadian Pony Club C or higher by October 12, 2020.
- Fee: \$200
- Competition subsidy of \$350 is provided at end of program through submission of LTED Completion Form by **October 12**, **2020**, which is solely the responsibility of the rider.
- Entry fee to HTNB horse trial (Peakaboo Corner) is included.

COMPETITIVE TIER 3 CRITERIA - Training (3'3") and EV105 (1.05m) Divisions

- As stated above, riders must attend Competitive Training Clinic and at least one other camp
 of their choice.
- Riders must compete in at least 1 HTNB competition AND 2 EC sanctioned horse trials (can include FEI CCI events, may be out-of-province).
- Riders to complete a minimum of 4+ lessons per month (May August) with **EC Certified Competition Coach** for a total of **18 lessons**. Lessons with EC Certified Instructors are not included at this level and do not count toward lesson requirements.
- At least 1-2 lessons/month must be a cross-country lesson for a total of **6 XC lessons**. Must be HTNB approved course with a HTNB XC **Competition Coach**.
- Must complete minimum EC Rider Level 6 or higher by October 12, 2020. Canadian Pony Club C1 for Training and Canadian Pony Club C2 for EV105 will be accepted.
- Fee: \$250
- Competition subsidy of \$500 is provided at end of program through submission of LTED Completion Form by **October 12, 2020**, which is solely the responsibility of the rider.
- Entry fee to HTNB derby (Brae Fearann) is included.
