1) ENTRIES: Each rider pays \$125 entry fee which provides access to 2 XC derby rounds. Each additional round costs \$10 and must be included on entry form. EC Levy and \$10 pinny deposit is included in entry fee – pinny deposit is returned when rider returns their pinny. Cheques made payable to Lori Leach. No refunds. Training riders require an EC passport.

Proof of annual shots, strangles vaccine, and negative coggins within 6 months required – no exceptions (without vet note).

Proper XC attire is mandatory. A XC clinic with Lori Leach will be offered July 27th at the farm. For info, see our Facebook page or website. Spectators welcome on course and volunteers always needed. Please contact us if you are able to lend a hand.

2) How the Derby Works: Stadium fences are added to the XC course. Placing based on riders first ride in the same division or higher division ridden if riding two different divisions. Entry Form will be available on website. Warm up on sand or grass – wear appropriate studs. All EC rules and policies are followed.

3) Memberships Required: HTNB, NBEA, Bronze EC

4) TIME SCHEDULE: Derby begins at 9 am beginning with Pre-Entry division.

5) OFFICIALS: Judge: Andrew Rommens; Cross Country: Lori Leach/Jeff Carter; Ground Jury: TBD

6) STABLING: \$30/stall. Limited stabling on grounds. Bring stall guards, shavings buckets, hay and feed. Initial shavings supplied. Limited stabling also available approx. 10 km from farm. First come first served.

7) AWARDS: Ribbons and great prizes this year! Sheets, saddle pads, etc.

8) DIRECTIONS: Off Trans Canada Highway, take Harvey/St. Stephen/St. Andrews exit; stay straight on Rte 3. Pass through village of Harvey up steep hill; farm on right (#2044).

9) OTHER INFORMATION: No dogs please. Please do not leave your horse tied to the trailer and unattended. We live on a busy road. First Aid responder on site. Vet on call or on site. Please ensure you clean up around your trailer before leaving

– bring a muck skip and a fork and take your waste home please. Water provided in tank outside. Please do not enter our barn unless you are stabling there. Portable toilet is on-site. No grazing horses in our paddocks. Biosecurity is taken seriously. See posted signs for Biosecurity rules.

Farm is located right in the village of Harvey which has restaurants and food stores and a gas station. Some food/drinks may be available for sale at farm.

Rain date will be arranged if footing is really wet. Watch Facebook announcements for updates.
