HUNTER/JUMPER

Coaching Experience

At least 2 years coaching experience producing athletes who are successfully completing courses at 1.0m in the hunter or jumper divisions at EC Silver or Gold shows (Any documentation providing evidence such as: Name of show, name of judges, a letter(s) from a sponsor/parent/rider supporting your coaching experience.)

EVENTING

Coaching Experience

At least 2 years coaching experience producing athletes meeting Minimum Eligibility Requirements (MER) at the national Training level or above. To complete the evaluation process, the candidate must show proof of having coached or be actively coaching a candidate at the national Preliminary level.
