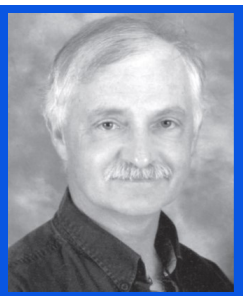
These awards recognize the contribution to community sport programs made by dedicated volunteers who have given countless hours so that athletes can enjoy the benefits of well-organized sports.

## Tom Hanson Coach of the Year Memorial Award

Western Valley Centre for Coaching Education renamed its Coach of the Year Award to "Tom Hanson Coach of the Year Memorial Award" in honor of a committee member who passed away in 2007.

Throughout the 1980's and 1990's under Tom's guidance, the Woodstock Rebels Softball Team excelled in on-field excellence and off-field sportsmanship. The ladies learned the finger points of the game and were encouraged to coach and mentor newer players on the team.

In 1991, Tom received the Softball NB's Coach of the Year Award. Tom took an active role in the Provincial softball organization, advocating for women's softball. He pushed for the inclusion of the Women's Masters category of the Provincial play. In 2006, the Woodstock Rebels team was inducted to the Softball NB Wall of Fame.

Tom was a student of the game of softball and he believed in the importance of good coaching. He achieved Level 3 of the National Coaching Certification program. He was a member of the Western Valley Centre for Coaching Education committee for over 10 plus years.
