A preparation course for Instructors' certification, the NCCP/EC Equestrian Theory workshop is a weekend course designed for candidates, Instructors, and Coaches (English and Western). This excellent seminar will benefit anyone currently coaching or thinking of coaching. These hours can also be used for updating purposes for all instructors and coaches.

This highly recommended two-day course takes you through the following modules:

- **Equestrian Teaching and Learning**: Understanding different learning styles, effective communication techniques and how to keep students focused and engaged are covered in this module.
- Planning An Equestrian Lesson: How to complete a lesson plan for a progressive and safe lesson.
- Analyzing Beginner Equestrian Performance: Identifying common equitation faults and their effect. Applying exercises to correct those equitation faults and improve general equitation in students is covered in this module.
- Making Ethical Decisions in the Equestrian Environment: The online evaluation must be completed by the candidate after completing this learning module. This section will be last, and need not be attended by people who already have this evaluation completed.
