1) ENTRIES: All divisions - \$120 plus EC drug fee (\$4). GST included in entry fee. Note: a photocopy of all current memberships (EC, NBEA, HTNB), signed waivers, proof of vaccinations, and full entry fee payment **must accompany entry.**

2) TIME SCHEDULE: Saturday July 30, office open 8am. Cross country open for course walks. Start times available July 26th, 2022. Ride times will be posted to the Brae Fearann Eventing Facility Facebook page.

3) OFFICIALS: TD: Marilyn Lacey. Dressage: Donna McInnis. Course Designer: Lori Leach. Ground jury to be confirmed.

4) STABLING: Copy of negative coggins test is required. \$30 including HST. Limited for first come first served. Hay and shavings NOT provided.

5) DRESSAGE: 2016 EC Tests. T – Training Test 2; PT – Pre-Training Test 2; E – Entry Test 2; PE – Entry Test 1; S – Entry Test 1. ARENA 20m x 40x sand ring. Warm up on grass.

6) CROSS COUNTRY: T – 2200 m @ 400-450mpm; PT – 2000m @ 400mpm; E 1500m @ 350mpm; PE/S – 1500m @ 300mpm. Terrain: rolling open terrain, spectator friendly, good galloping course.

7) AWARDS: Prizes to 3rd, Ribbons to 5th.

8) DIRECTIONS: From Trans-Canada Highway: Exit 258 St. Stephen/St. Andrews, 18 km along Route 3, civic address 2044 Route 3 after passing through main village. From Charlotte County: Follow signs to Lawrence Station, then to Harvey Station, civic address 2044 Route 3 before main village of Harvey.

9) OTHER INFORMATION: Veterinary and farrier on call. Medic on the grounds. Concession on grounds. Additional cross country schooling rounds can be ridden after the official round and at the end of the division in which they are competing. Water and toilet available onsite. No dogs permitted.
