- **\$1206.16** in funding awarded





Last winter in the terrific wind storm, there were trees down on the Club grounds that caused considerable damage. This was an unexpected expensive we were faced with in the spring.


Fortunately, NBEA offered to partner with us and we received \$240.00 towards the expense of the removal of the trees.
