# Zone 3 funding terms of reference

<u>Overarching principles:</u> each year, the Zone 3 committee applies for funding from the province of New Brunswick and therefore, these funds must be spent on activities supported by this operational grant. The Zone 3 committee's primary mandate is to promote equestrian sports in the zone while following NBEA and EC best practices. All funding applications must therefore comply with these best practices.

In the interest of fairness to all members of the zone, the Zone 3 committee reserves the right to limit the amount of funding to be allocated to any one individual or barn. Activities that benefit all members of the zone may be prioritized over activities that benefit a single individual or barn. Funding approval is subject to the availability of funds, therefore we encourage members to inform us of upcoming activities for which they will request funding as early as possible. Financial planning by the committee happens in March of each year.

#### **Eligibility for funding:**

- Must live within Zone 3 (refer to NBEA.ca for zone boundaries)
- Must hold a current membership with the New Brunswick Equestrian Association

#### **Examples of activities that can be funded:**

- Organization or participation in a rider-focused clinic or workshop
- Cost of being evaluated for EC coaching certification
- Cost of upgrading coaching certification or maintaining coaching status
- Cost of EC rider level evaluation (note: only one rider level per rider will be funded in any given year)
- Cost of training or shadowing to become an official (e.g., stewards, judges) or to evaluate EC rider levels

### Examples of activities that <u>cannot</u> be funded:

- Organization or participation in horse-focused clinics (ie, hoof care clinic, equine first aid, etc.)
- Cost of insurance for coaches
- Costs associated with organizing or participating in horse shows

On an exceptional basis, and when funding is available from other sources than the province of New Brunswick annual grant, the committee may consider supporting riders who travel outside the zone for events or shows when they are not available within the zone (for example, year-end championship show or gold-sanctioned shows using Zone 3 fundraising revenue).
