On behalf of the Ambulatory Equine Service and the Atlantic Veterinary College (AVC) Veterinary Teaching Hospital (VTH), we would like to thank you for allowing us to provide service to you in New Brunswick (NB) since 2016. We have reached the decision that our current focus must now turn to providing service from within our home province of Prince Edward Island (PEI) to meet the needs of our clientele in PEI and Atlantic Canada most efficiently.

To focus our resources in PEI, we have come to the difficult decision to temporarily pause our arrangement, following the provision of one further visit to NB, which has been tentatively scheduled for May 15-17, 2024.
