Bio-Security

- a. The show will be conducted in compliance with the COVID precautions in force at the time. **The latest restrictions will be posted before the show and during the show day.**
- b. Competitors are advised not to bring horses to the show that exhibit any symptoms of illness.
- c. Competitors are advised not to share equipment between horses.
- d. Direct contact between horses is discouraged.
- e. Competitors are advised as to the risk of grazing horses where other horses have grazed.
- f. Stalls will be cleaned.
- g. If you have a horse that shows any indication of illness you must notify the competition office. Examples:
 - An equine with a body temperature more than 39°C;
 - Persistent cough and/or labored breathing at rest;
 - Abnormal nasal discharge;
 - An equine that is ataxic or recumbent;
 - An equine with persistent diarrhea;
 - An equine with oral or coronary band vesicular or ulcerative lesion; and
 - An equine that demonstrates either aggressive behavior or stupor.
- h. As directed by competition management, owners will be asked to quarantine horses that show signs of illness.

Costs incurred for veterinary care are the responsibility of the equine owner.

Equestrian Canada - Statement of Principles

Horse Welfare

9. EC supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.
10. EC is committed to:
 - a) upholding the welfare of the horse, regardless of monetary value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
 - b) requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
 - c) ensuring that owners, trainers, and exhibitors and their agents exercise appropriate care and responsibility in the handling, treatment, and transportation of their horses, as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
 - d) providing for the continuous wellbeing of the horse by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, and safety;
 - e) continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
 - f) requiring owners, trainers, and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions; and,
 - g) reviewing, revising, and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.
11. In determining whether conduct or treatment is cruel, abusive or inhumane, the standard to be applied will be the conduct or treatment expected of a reasonable person who is informed and experienced in equine training and exhibition procedures.
12. Individuals who interact with horses must also adhere to EC's policies as they relate to horse welfare.

\$20.00 per horse, administration fee

\$15.00 per in hand, junior exhibitor, performance or other regular class

\$25.00 per championship class

\$4.00 per horse Medical Certification Fee (drug testing)

\$50.00 per weekend per horse or tack stall (**Belongings must be kept in a tack stall or removed from the barn.**)

Horses may be moved into the barns Friday afternoon July 12, 2024. Baled Shavings are available for purchase from the PLP. Exhibitors are free to bring their own shavings or sawdust from home. Straw, peat moss or other forms of bedding are not

permitted. If another form of bedding is required for health reasons, the exhibitor must contact the Show Centre manager in advance of the show.

General Show Rules

Rule reference numbers are included throughout this document, you can look up the rules in detail, for free, at <https://www.equestrian.ca/programs-services/rules>. For General Rules see Sec. A, for Breed Rules see Sec. B.

1. **ABUSE OF HORSES WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
2. Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location.
3. Competitors' numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise rings, as well as the competition ring. (A814). There will be a charge of \$5.00 each for back numbers. This will be refunded when the numbers are returned to the show secretary at the end of the show.
4. All horses must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor or under legal lease (copy of which must be provided). Horses purchased on time are permitted to be shown and entered in any class under the Purchaser's name providing a written contract of sale can be produced to the Show Secretary.
5. All cheques are to be made payable to the NB MORGAN HORSE CLUB. No postdated cheques will be accepted after the official closing date for entries.
6. Owner's full name, complete address, and postal code must be on entry form.
7. There is no fee for Championship In-Hand classes, horses must qualify for entry. The first and second place horses will be called back for the championship classes.
8. Ribbons will be awarded to five places. Trophies or prizes may be presented in some classes. Perpetual Trophies must be returned the following year, if you have one of these trophies please bring it with you.
9. An open class is one which is open to all horses of any age irrespective of the ribbons previously won and in which there are no qualifications for the rider/driver.
10. **All horses attending Equestrian Canada sanctioned competitions must have met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article 519, Vaccinations.** All horses attending the EC sanctioned competition must have met the requirements of Article A519, vaccinations. It is also strongly recommended horses be inoculated against rabies and strangles. Any persistent coughing or obviously ill horse will be barred from the show grounds. It is also strongly recommended that horses have a current negative coggins test.
11. The judge must order from the ring any unruly or unsafe horse or rider.
12. There will be no refund of class fees unless the horse is withdrawn due to serious illness or injury to the horse (veterinary certification required) or serious illness, injury or death in the exhibitor's family. In these cases, 75% of entry fees 100% of Equine medications, stabling fees and number fees will be refunded. No refund on administration fee. If horse is already on competition grounds only 75% of entry fees will be refunded. A suitable horse may be substituted with no added fee.
13. **Scratches** Exhibitors **must** notify the show secretary and/or in-gate attendant well before the class if they withdraw their entry from a class or change rider/driver. It is important to have proper information on show result forms. Classes begin no later than **5 minutes** after the last horse leaves the ring from the previous class.
14. **Tack holds** Exhibitors must notify the show secretary and/or in-gate attendant a minimum of three classes prior to the requested hold. Conduct of hold: The gate will be closed after previous class exits ring and will stay closed until the competitor who requested the hold is ready or the allotted hold time has expired. The gate will then be opened and all

competitors will enter the ring. Tack hold will be an additional **three minutes** added to time allowed between classes.

15. The indoor show ring will be open for use 12:00 noon the day prior to the commencement of the show and will close at 9:00 PM that night. Other schooling times TBA.
16. Priority in the warm-up ring is for horses in the next class. **No lunging in permitted in the arena when a mounted rider is present, there is also no lunging in the warm up ring during competition hours.** There will be no conduct in the warm-up area or in-gate area, which disturbs or creates a hazard to the horses or handlers. Bag whips, noise makers, rattlers, chains, buckets and cans with rocks, or other equipment, devices or objects which might disturb a horse or exhibitor or create a hazard to horses or handlers in the paddock or in-gate area are prohibited. Please clear the ingate area promptly when exiting the ring to allow the next entries to enter safely.
17. Horses shall be shown at all gaits both ways of the ring. In harness classes, drivers shall remain seated until all entries have been inspected and judged. One attendant without whip must head each horse in Park and Pleasure Driving classes. In Pleasure classes horses may be asked to back. Stallions **MUST** always be under control and shown by a competent handler.
18. Junior Exhibitors are prohibited from showing stallions in any class or division at this competition.
19. The show reserves the right to cancel a class if there are less than three entries
20. Parking is available on the grounds. Please park horse trailers between Barn 3 and the hockey arena or next to the barns to keep the warm-up area uncluttered. Travel trailers parked by the outdoor ring may not be moved during competition hours.
21. Entries may leave the show grounds following their last class.
22. As per Equine Canada rule A805, the show committee reserves the right to refuse or limit any entry, except as provided in EC Rule A805.2.
23. Payment for professional services or consultations performed by the Show Veterinarian, Farrier or Photographer will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. The New Brunswick Morgan Horse Club, show committee or other representatives are not responsible for payment of these services.
24. For insurance purposes, all horses must have a stall. Tying to trailers is not permitted.
25. Entry forms must be signed by the exhibitor, owner and person responsible. If the owner or exhibitor is a junior, the entry must be signed by a parent or legal guardian. The entry form for all sanctioned competitions shall also be signed by the person responsible for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse. By definition, the Person Responsible is the individual responsible and accountable for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse. The Person Responsible may be the trainer, owner, rider, driver, agent or coach. The Person Responsible must be an adult who holds a valid EC Sport License. The person responsible is to be present at the competition and if they cannot attend must appoint a representative and notify the competition secretary. Parents/guardians are not required to have an EC Sport License provided they agree to abide by the rules and penalties contained in the Rule Book and acknowledge that they are liable under the penalty provisions of the Rules for any violations of the EC Rules by their minor child.
26. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. This show will run in accordance with the Code of Ethics of Equine Canada. Any situation requiring a ruling which cannot be referenced according to the Equine Canada rules will be rendered by the Show Committee.
27. Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in this EC- sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition.
28. **PRESENTATION OF THE SIGNED ENTRY FORM SHALL BE DEEMED AS ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES, AND ALL RULES OF EQUINE CANADA.** Equine Canada Rules are available free online at www.equinecanada.ca.

29. When registering for EC sanctioned competitions, athletes must indicate the name of their coach on the entry form or specify that they are self-coached. Coaches from other countries, must be in good-standing with their home federation and must declare/have proof of insurance . See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article 102, Safe Sport Environments.
30. Hors Concours entries will not be permitted in the competition.

Arabian Breed Show Rules

1. All horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, the Arabian Horse Registry of America or the Arabian Horse Association or if under one year of age, be eligible for registration and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabians refer to Section B, Chapter 41 of the EC Rules for registration requirements. A photocopy of papers must accompany the entry. Only horses under one year that have had registration applied for may show without papers. (B1304)
2. The Arabian must wear a long, natural unbraided mane (with or without clipped bridle path) and a natural unset, unaltered/un-gingered tail. No horse may compete in a class in the Arabian or Half/Anglo Arabian Division with a tail carriage that has been altered in any manner or by any means. Violations of this rule are considered serious infractions, because such alterations constitute misrepresentations of the breed type. **Exception:** Horses shown in Hunter, Show Hack, Jumper, Dressage, Sport Horse or Western Dressage. Appointments, or where permitted under the discipline rules are permitted to show with a shortened, pulled, braided mane. Horses with dead or flaccid tails or who exhibit evidence of constricting device on tail must be severely penalized or eliminated from judging consideration. The use of glitter on or in the mane, tail hair or on the hooves is prohibited. Any change of colour or markings is prohibited. Only clear grooming materials are allowed on hide and hair. Materials may be used to remove stains. Colouring of the chestnut is prohibited. (B1304.4)
3. In the Arabian division, juniors are 18 years and under as of Dec. 1 of the competition year. Adult amateurs are 19 years and over as of Dec. 1 of the competition year. The competition year for Arabian competitions runs from Dec. 1 of the previous year to Nov. 30 of the current year. The age requirements set out in this rule defining adults and juniors shall supersede the definition for “junior(s)” and “adult(s)” set out in all Equestrian Canada rules, regulations, agreements and policies applicable to the Arabian division. (B1402.10)
4. Horses under two years of age must be shown barefoot. Horses two years of age may be shown with shoes; however the use of bar shoes or pad(s) of any configuration between the hoof and shoe is prohibited. Horses three years of age. Any machine made (keg) or handmade shoe made from magnetic steel, mild steel, aluminum, rubber or other non-metallic material is allowable. No part of the shoe may exceed the dimensions of 3/8 inch thick by 1-1/8 inches wide. Aluminum, rubber or other non-metallic shoes are exempt from dimension requirements for the Arabian, Half/Anglo Arabian Division. Shoes made of tungsten carbide are prohibited. The shoe may be of any type and configuration except in the case of a bar shoe, there may only be one bar, which in the case of a straight bar, can be located anywhere within the circumference of the shoe; or an egg bar, an uninterrupted oval shaped shoe. The bar is part of the shoe and must not exceed the dimensions of 3/8” thick by 1 1/8” wide at any point on the shoe, nor may the bar extend below the ground surface of the shoe. If a shoe band is used, it may be attached to the shoe or pad if present. Duct tape may be used for emergency shoe repair. All horses competing in the Arabian, Half-Anglo Arabian Working Hunter, Jumper, Dressage, Eventing, Combined Driving Pleasure (Carriage) Driving, Sport Horse, Reining Seat Equitation and Working Western Sections shall be exempt. This DOES NOT exempt horses that are cross-entered into any other classes from compliance with applicable shoeing requirements while competing in those classes. Maximum length of toe is 4-3/4 inches. NOTE: Half-Arabians & Anglo-Arabians maximum toe length is 5 1/4 inches. (B1304.7)
5. Horses must be shown without artificial appliances. Anything that alters the intended use of equipment as provided for in the description of appointments for a given class is considered to be an artificial appliance. This includes but is not limited to nasal strips, tongue ties and/or mouth ties. Gag bits are prohibited Exception: Jumper classes. Boots and bandages are prohibited except in Jumper, Hunter Seat Equitation over Fences, Reining, Cutting, Working Cow, Reining Seat Equitation and Gymkhana classes. Action produced by artificial methods must be penalized. The use of leg chains, rollers, hock hobbles or similar devices on the show grounds during or before a show are prohibited and the show committee shall bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the show, and they shall forfeit all entry fees and winnings for the entire show. Ear plugs are legal, EXCEPT in Dressage classes, Chapter 23. (B1304.5).
6. Any competitor may wear protective headgear and/or a protective safety vest, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. (B1501.22c)

7. Junior Exhibitors must wear protective headgear during schooling and warm up. Junior Exhibitors participating in classes which allow western hats or derbies may wear traditional headgear during their class changing from protective headgear dismounted when the class preceding enters the competition arena.
8. High Point award will be calculated on horse/handler combination in one division: Arabian Junior Exhibitor – Eligible classes are: 32, 44, 60, 69, 71, 89, 94, 95, 103, 112, 113
