Out-of-Maritimes Competitor Travel Funding Non-EC Sanctioned Competitions Application 2025

DESCRIPTION:

As part of the NBEA's commitment to athlete development through the Long-Term Equestrian Development plan (LTED), funding is available to support athletes who have traveled to compete at sanctioned competitions outside the Maritime provinces, *including competitions sanctioned by the AQHA, APHA, or other national governing body*. The total amount of funding awarded will depend on the number of applications received and the amount of each applicant's outlay.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicant must:

- ✓ Be a NBEA member in good standing
- ✓ Be a resident of New Brunswick
- ✓ Have competed in **at least 2 sanctioned competitions** in New Brunswick in 2025
- ✓ Complete separate applications for each horse competed
- ✓ **Have attended nationally-sanctioned competition outside of the Maritime provinces**

APPLICATION DEADLINE: October 1st, 2025.

SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS:

- Applications should be submitted as **one** PDF file via email to horses@nbnet.nb.ca. Missing information will disqualify the application from the competition. Applications submitted after October 1st *will not be considered*.

 1. A fully completed application form
 2. Proof of competition – link to results, scan of results
