



New Brunswick Hunter/Jumper 2014 Canadian Interprovincial Equestrian Championships Qualification Criteria

Goal

To select and prepare a full jumper team, consisting of two Junior and two Senior riders, competing at the 1.10m (3'7") Jumper level, to represent New Brunswick at the Canadian Interprovincial Equestrian Championships (CIEC) to be held in Blainville, Quebec on October 3-5, 2014.

Training Camp

To be determined. Anticipate training camps to be held in New Brunswick with all team members participating. Plan to arrive at Blainville competition facility prior to competition to train as a team.

Qualifying Criteria

- Riders interested in selection to the New Brunswick Jumper Team must declare their intention by submitting the Declaration Form to the NBEA by May 19th, 2014. Applications must include a \$25 application fee for each declared horse/rider combination. See attached application form.
- 2. Junior: A rider who is 17 years of age and under as of January 1st, 2014. Senior: A rider who is 18 years of age or over as of January 1st, 2014.
- 3. A competitor may not compete in these Championships if he/she has competed at the Jumping Championships for Juniors or Young Riders at the NAYRC. Competitors must not have competed above the 1.20m level in 2014 in order to be eligible.
- 4. Riders declaring two or more horses will only be eligible for one Team position.
- 5. Because the CIEC's are an EC Bronze level competition, New Brunswick Team candidates and horse owners, require a valid NBEA and EC Bronze or Gold membership to compete in qualifying classes and meet all competition requirements.
- 6. Riders must be NB residents and be current members of the NBEA for 2014.

Team Qualification

- Riders must participate in 1.10m Jumper Division at a minimum of 4 sanctioned Bronze, Silver or Gold competitions in Canada, or equivalent sanctioned competition in the USA.
- 1.10m Jumper classes will be offered at 4 Bronze/Gold Hunter Jumper Shows in New Brunswick (2 at Geary Hill Stables, 2 at Foshay South)
- Riders must submit results for 4 competitions to the NBEA and provide video for competitions outside NB.

Selection Criteria

Team Size

Each provincial team must be composed of a minimum of 2 riders and a maximum of 4 riders, with a minimum of 1 Junior on the team. In the event that the province cannot enter a full team, individual athletes may represent the province. Each province that cannot enter a team may enter one or two individual competitors, with one horse each. Points earned by individual competitors will only be counted towards Individual Awards.

Team Requirements

Riders must ensure that their horses have a valid negative Coggin's test within 6 months of competition, and all documents required for competition.

Riders must participate in Team Training Clinics in NB prior to the CIEC's. Riders may continue to train with their own coach and individual riders may bring their personal coach to Blainville, but approval from the Team Chef d'Equipe must be obtained prior to the start of the CIEC's for the coach to be present in the warm-up and competition rings. Rider is responsible for any costs associated with attendance of their personal coach if they choose to attend.

Stabling fees and entry fees will be paid for. Additional expenses may be subsidized to some extent by the NBEA. However, riders must be prepared to be responsible for all of, or a portion of, all personal expenses incurred while participating as a team member.
