LEARN HOW TO TEACH CLINIC

This Learn How to Teach Clinic is designed to complement the Instructor of Beginners Preparation Training (IOB Prep) and is helpful for anyone who is planning on doing their IOB evaluation. During this Clinic, demonstrations of the correct method for teaching unmounted lessons, teaching lunge lessons and teaching group lessons of three or more riders. This Clinic is a great stepping stone for the IOB preps which provides a venue for candidates to run through simulated evaluations with feedback from an Evaluator to prepare for the real evaluation.

The Learn How to Teach Clinic is a valuable introduction to the certification program and is meant to develop or/and improve teaching skills. Coaches and mentors are also encouraged to attend as this Clinic will provide insight into the skills which are sought in new instructors. Updating hours are available.
